

Credit is granted for Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate (IB) examinations. Credit may also be awarded for “A-Level” examinations taken in secondary education abroad. A maximum of 9 credits in all subjects may be earned through credit-by-examination. If more than one type of examination (AP, IB, A-Levels) is taken in the same subject, credit will be awarded for only one of the exams. Credits earned by examination can be used toward your Knox degree but do not satisfy Foundation (general education) requirements. Credits may be counted toward your major or minor, at the discretion of the department.

## INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE EXAMINATIONS

Students completing an IB Diploma with a score of 30 or above will receive one year of credit toward the completion of their Knox degree. Credit will be granted to Diploma recipients scoring below 30, and to students completing only IB certificates, as follows: Credit for two Knox courses will be awarded for each IB Higher Level examination passed with a score of 4 or above. Standard examinations passed with a score of 5 or above will receive credit for one Knox course. Up to one year of credit can be awarded.

## CAMBRIDGE A-LEVEL EXAMINATIONS

Students who have completed their secondary education abroad and have “Advanced Level” passes in liberal arts subjects may receive credit that counts toward graduation. The awarding of the credit is dependent upon the A-Level grade received, the testing syndicate which granted it, and the approval of the relevant Knox department and the Registrar. A minimum grade of C (3) is required for consideration. Application for credit is made during the first year in residence at Knox. A maximum of two credits may be awarded for each examination, as recommended by the department.
